

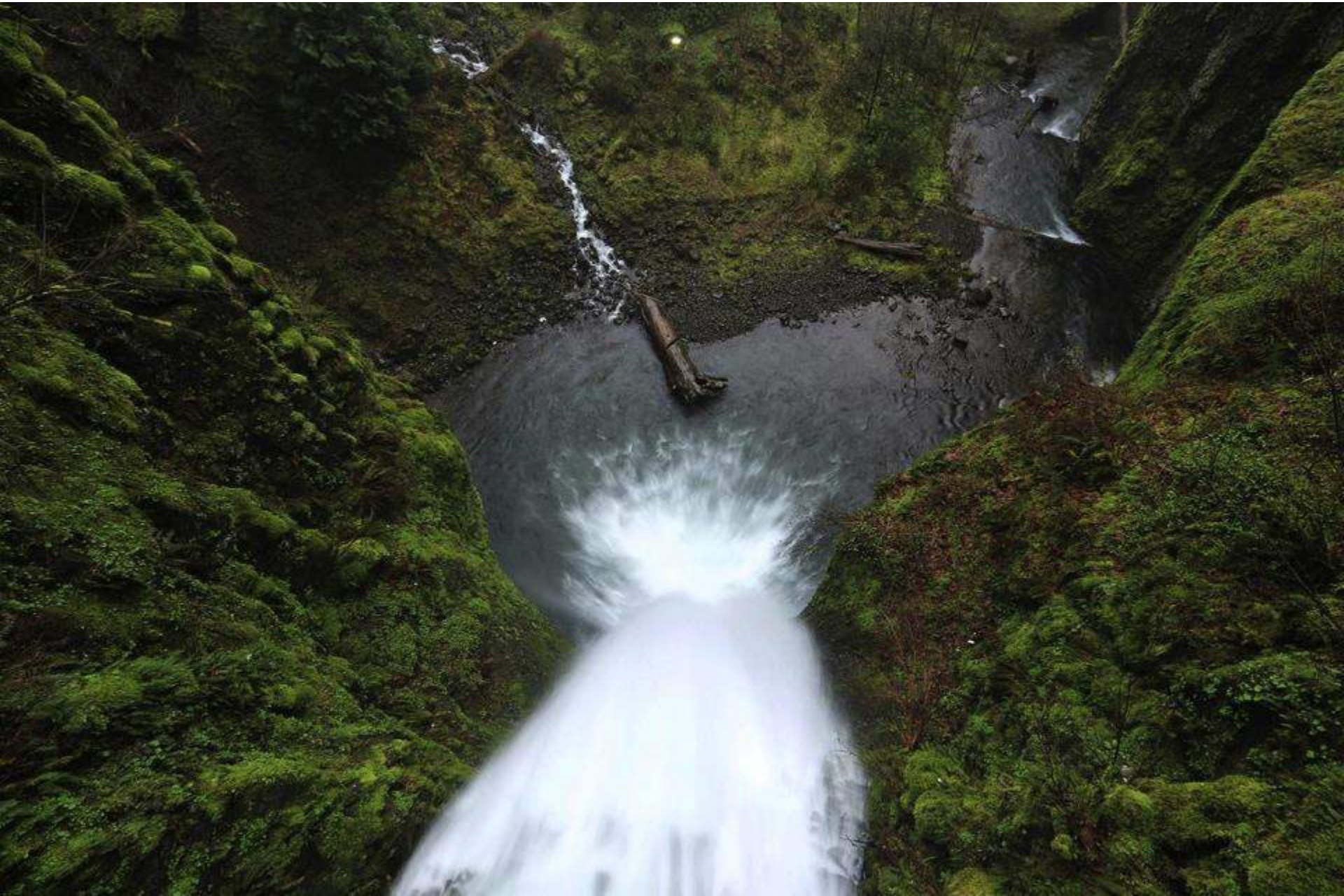

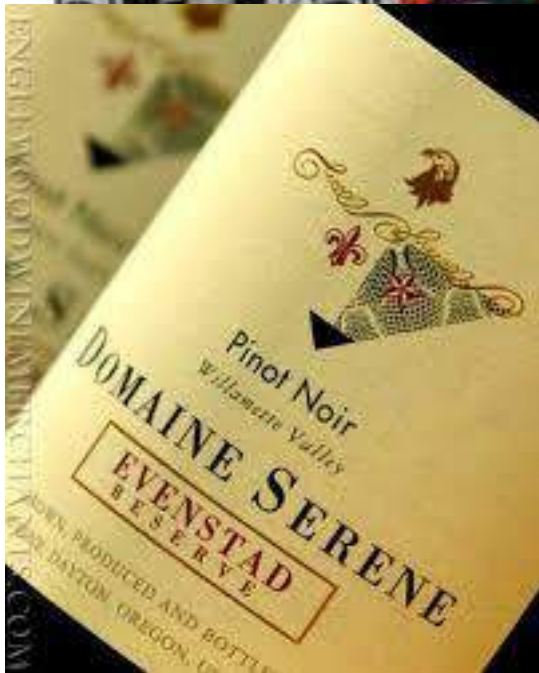
# Mirjam (think Miriam) Metcalf

- Love College Football (Ducks my adopted team), cooking, avid wine collector, gardening

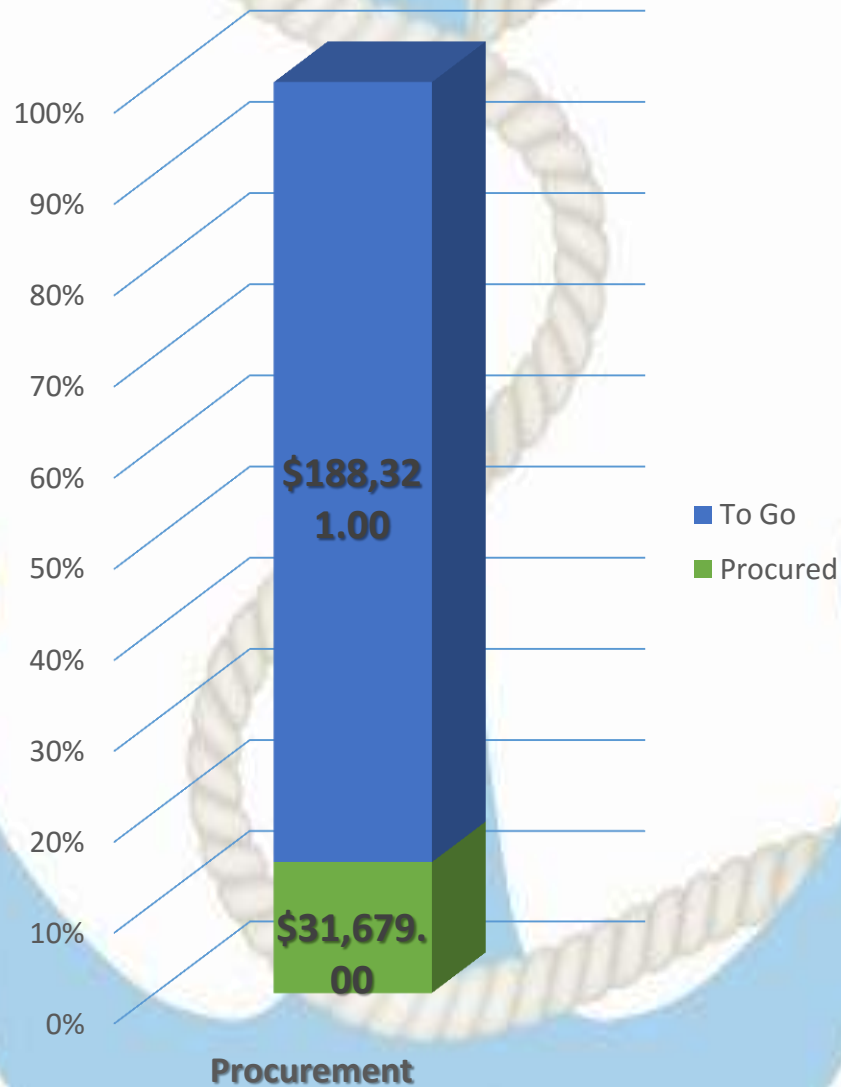

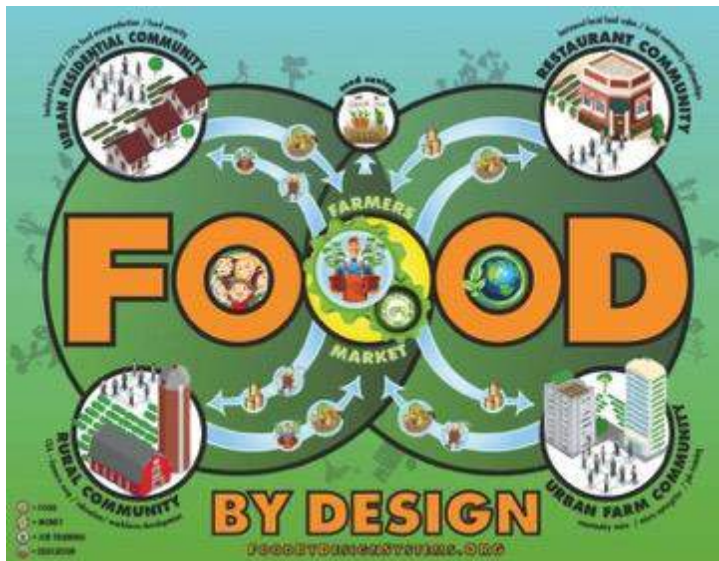
