

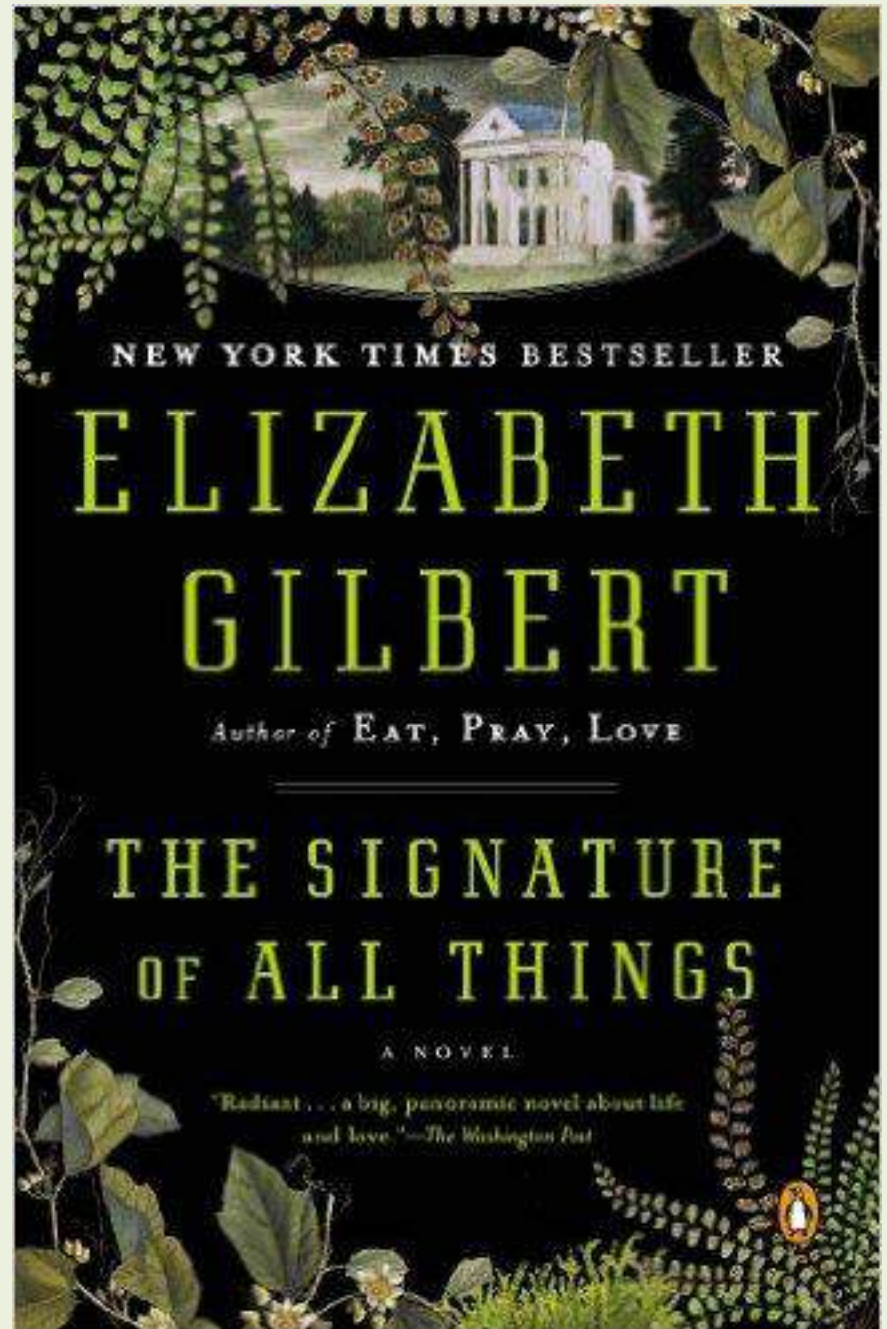

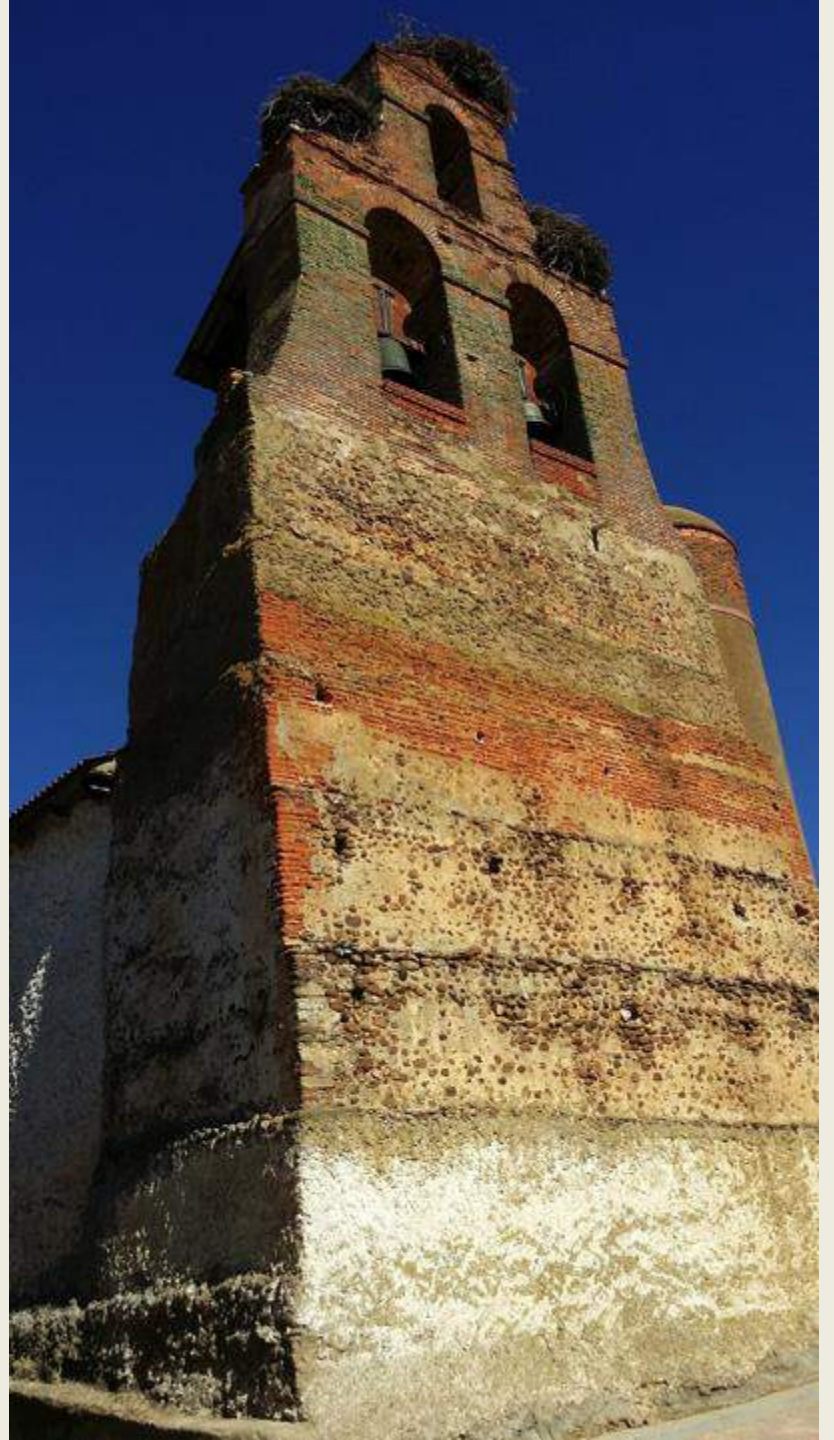

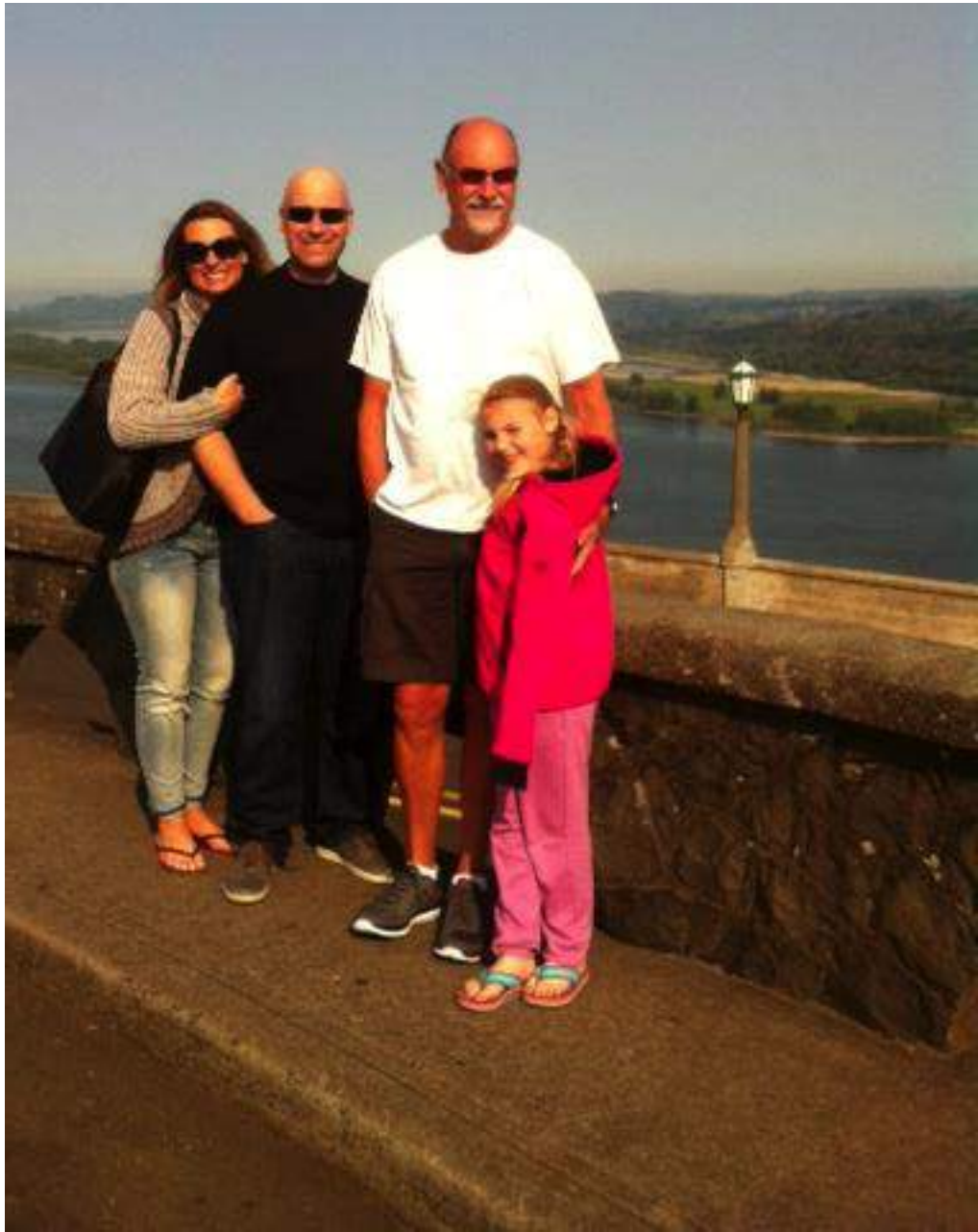






Kris Clancy
