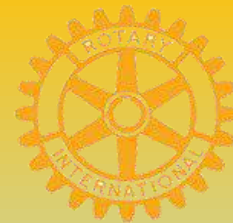

# Shelter Box --Haiti

- **Port au Prince largely untouched, but southern peninsula devastated**
- Emergency shelter experts from ShelterBox are now in Haiti assessing damage and need in a country reeling from yet another natural catastrophe. Hurricane Matthew has left hundreds dead and hundreds of thousands in need of help



Speed of recovery may be helped by ShelterBox's model of pre-positioned aid – 369 tents and 77 complete ShelterBoxes already await distribution in Port au Prince, a further 1,310 Shelter kits, mosquito nets and water filtration equipment are ready to be shipped from Panama, and 323 ShelterBoxes are aboard Dutch Navy vessels steaming out Curacao.
