#### More on Bill Ramirez

- Bill has been an adjunct professor at Portland State University since 2010 where he teaches classes in taxation.
- Bill has recorded more than 1,250 volunteer hours at the Oregon Zoo. He participated in a 4-year study of the zoo's elephants.
- At the Oregon Humane Society, Bill has contributed more than 780 volunteer hours. For the last 5 years, he has been Santa Paws.
- Tax Executives Institute ("TEI") presented Bill with its President Award in 2009 for helping found its European Chapter and organizing its Asian Chapter.
- The International Tax Review in 2007 recognized Bill as one of the top 10 Tax Directors in Asia.
- Bill lived for 6 years in Brussels, Belgium; 10 years in Lausanne, Switzerland and 4 years in Hong Kong. In the U.S., Bill has lived in Chicago, Houston, New York City and San Francisco. Bill has travelled to 75 countries.
- Bill has a Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting from Texas Tech; a J.D. in law from the University of Iowa and an LLM in Taxation from DePaul University.
- Bill and his wife, Roberta, moved to West Linn in 2008. Bill and Roberta met at church in Houston and were married in San Francisco. Next year will be Bill & Roberta's 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

- America into space. In the 1940s and 50s, when the newly created Jet Propulsion Laboratory needed quick-thinking mathematicians to calculate velocities and plot trajectories, they didn't turn to male graduates.
