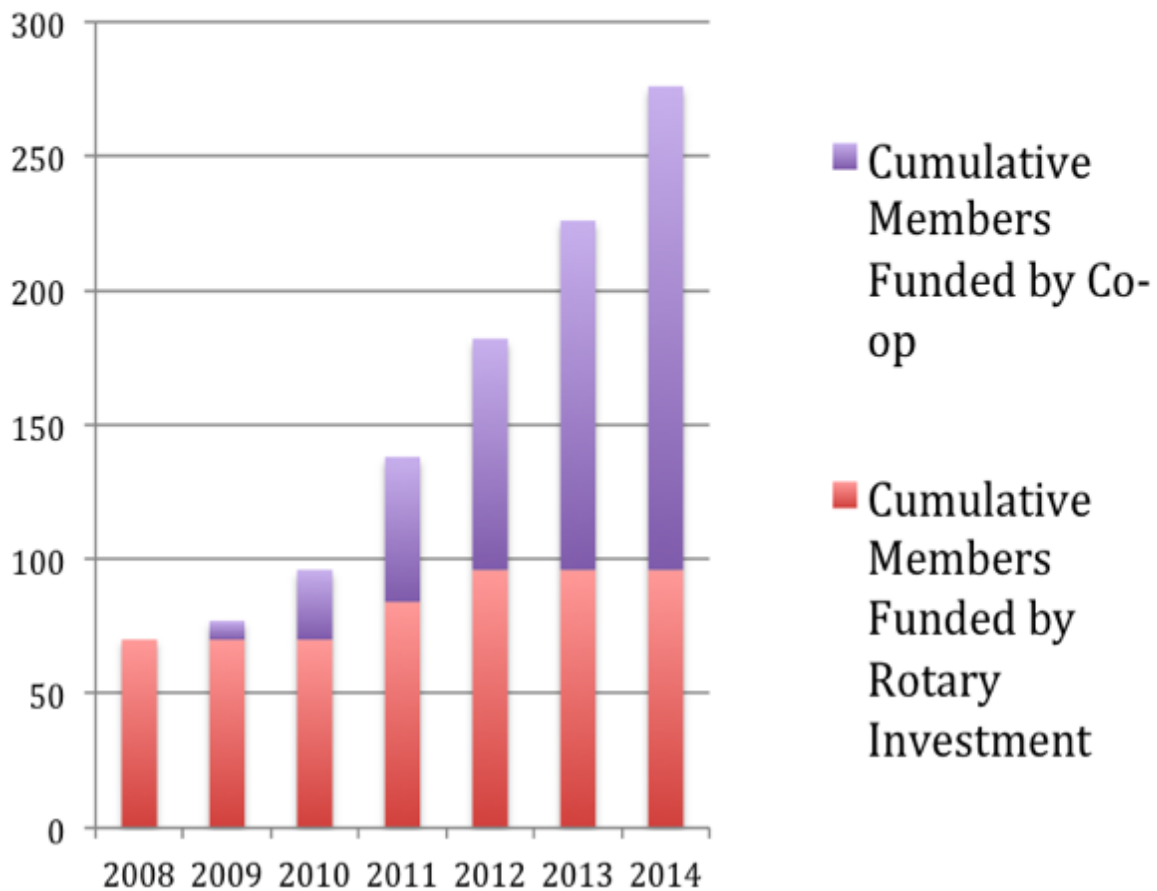

|--|-----------------------------|--------------------------------|
| Families eating meals 3 times per day | 11% | 96% |
| Families eating meat, fish, or poultry 3+ times per week | 31% | 79% |
| Children who have a mattress or a bed | 13% | 87% |
| Households owning a radio | 32% | 60% |

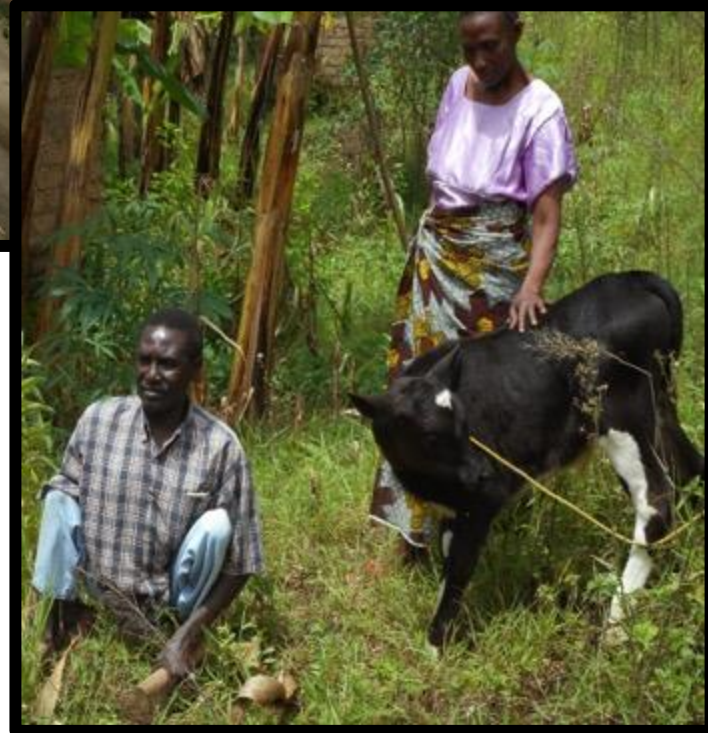
