

Lake Oswego Rotary Club Service Above Self: Educational Excellence

2017 SASEE Scholarship Application



As a part of the recently created Service Above Self: Educational Excellence Awards, the Rotary Club of Lake Oswego will award scholarships to high school seniors who plan to attend college in the fall. The purpose of these scholarships is to encourage service to others in school and the community.

Three scholarships will be awarded to seniors who live in Lake Oswego or attend high school there. These scholarships are in the amount of \$2,000 and, as always, will be awarded without regard to race, religion, gender, disability, or any other legally protected status.

The three scholarships are presented this year in the names of the 2017 recipients of the SASEE Citizen Award for community service. These three are:

- Linda Brown
- Piper Park
- Sandra Miller

The scholarships will be judged by members of the Rotary Club of Lake Oswego. Recipients will be chosen based primarily on their commitment to community service. Consideration may also be given to academic success and leadership but the primary consideration will be the applicant's adherence to the Rotary motto, Service Above Self.

Payment of each scholarship will be made during the recipient's first term, directly to the institution of higher learning in which the recipient is enrolled. Scholarship recipients will be announced in June, and will be invited to speak at a Rotary Club meeting.

The applicant must be a graduating senior and attend an institution of higher learning within twelve months following application for the award.

Applying for the Rotary Club Scholarships

Each application must include the following:

- 1. Student's Name, address, email address, cell phone number, photo JPG, parent's/guardian's name
- 2. A complete high school transcript
- 3. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member who is well acquainted with the applicant's high school career
- 4. A 300-500 word essay delineating the reasons why the applicant believes he or she qualifies for the scholarship and providing evidence to support those qualifications

Additionally, each application must include answers to the following:

A. What is your status with respect to applications for admission to colleges and universities? To which schools have you applied? Where have you been accepted?

B. Have you already in hand, or do you expect to receive a full tuition scholarship or grant which you intend to use to fund your education?
