
Greetings Fellow Rotarians,

China's first Rotary club started in Shanghai in 1919 as one of the first Rotary clubs in Asia but Rotary left China in 1951 due to political reasons. In



2006, Rotary is back in China, we have now 29 clubs in 12 cities.

Rotary China is one of the 3 areas that are "undistributed" by RI but treat it the same as any other district worldwide. Instead of DG, My position is: "Special Representative" appointed by the Rotary International president instead of elected by the clubs.
