

The Najijali Project has launched in Chwele, Kenya! Our first class of 25 girls are in school at the Chwele Vocational Training Centre, and their children are being cared for at the new Childcare Centre.

This was made possible by an international teamwork of Rotarians. With the support of members from the Rotary Clubs of White Salmon-Bingen, Tigard, and Bungoma Magharibi, leadership from District 5100 and 9212, and the MANY clubs and individuals who simply care about empowering girls - this program is now a reality!
