Many of you know that Rotary has a heart for children. Five years ago, twenty of our Rotary Districts Clubs join forces to help fund fifty students Tuition and room and board in Kenya. Battle Ground Rotary chose to fund five of the fifty. The Club funds were matched by Rotary International grants to provide opportunities to high potential children whose parents are no longer in the picture or who could not afford providing their children such an opportunity.



Members of our District have a close working relationship with the Rise To Shine Executive Director and have made several trips to the school to ensure the effect use of our funds.

We've highlighted Rise to Shine at our Festival of Wreaths Fundraiser each year as we see this program making a significant difference in the lives of these children and their communities.
