Treasurer's Report: Laurie reviewed the treasurer report. All agreed to get rid of photo booth. We have not used the money from the district for technology. Susan Blane, Membership: Susan is the new director.

Terri Baker, Club Service/Admin: Discussion about using the Mission for our weekly meetings. Terri stated that we have evolving needs and the Mission does not require a contract. Some concerns expressed were that the Mission was unsafe and unprofessional. Concerns appear to come from two members. There have not been any safety issues reported. We are a service organization, and the Mission provides services. The room is nicely decorated, and 86% of members surveyed reported that the Mission venue is good to excellent and 100% rated the meals as excellent. Twenty members completed the survey. The Board agreed that we will continue to hold our weekly meetings at the mission for the next 6 months.

Chris asked that we be respectful to the staff at the mission and address issues if we hear disrespectful comments to the staff. There have been comments about no fruit salad, and a spoon not being big enough. There was a suggestion that we have an ambassador at the food line to monitor.
