Beth, Community Service: Absent. Gael shared the budget and funding for the Peru Global Grant. We will ask for \$2000 at the District Grant Meeting. It will be presented & voted on at the District Meeting on July 7. Kim reported that the District Grant, 23-24, is ready to close out. She shared that 2022-2023 Rotary Year, we funded \$500 for the Ukraine, Chris approved \$1500 for the Corvallis Sanitation Project Grant. The grant has not come to fruition. Kim stated that we need to check on this at the District Grant meeting. Our District Grant for 2022-23 was \$5,000. Our \$2,000 plus the 1.5 match of \$3,000. We purchased 3 medical backpack kits and 2 CPR training kits for Ukraine, via the club in Poland. That grant is in the process of closing.
