

▶ Need a Scholarship?

These scholarships are administered by the **Rotary Club of Redmond Scholarship Committee** and payable to the instruction of higher education that the applicant enrolls in.

All applications are due March 31st 2025.

▶ **Newhouse Scholarship for Agriculture and Manufacturing** is **\$3500** a year renewable scholarship up to **\$14,000** established by the Newhouse Foundation To help students to pursue careers in Agriculture, Manufacturing, or a related field. *Applications are to be submitted using this electronic application.* →



▶ **The Redmond Rotary Agriculture Scholarship** is a **\$2,000** a year renewable award of **\$8,000** established by the Rotary Club of Redmond to further the educational progress of area students who are interested in pursuing an agricultural related field. *Applications are to be submitted using this electronic application.* →



▶ **The Redmond Rotary Short Essay Leadership \$3,100** annually, renewable for up to four years (totaling **\$12,400**) Scholarship focus is "Service Above Self" *Applications are to be submitted using this electronic application.* →



To fill out applications, you will need the following documents ready to upload when requested:

- 1.) A copy of your most up-to-date academic transcript.
- 2.) Two letters of recommendation
- 3.) A list of school and community activities. The list should include who sponsored the activity and how many hours you participated in the activity. This could include any in school or out of school activities. i.e. school service clubs, FFA or religious groups. Please identify any service activities that were sponsored by Rotary: i.e. Berry sales, County fair ticket taking, etc.

*The Rotary Scholarships have been established by the Rotary Club of Redmond, Oregon to further the educational progress of area students. Our goals are to promote the Rotary ideal of "Service Before Self", therefore scholarship applicants who have demonstrated actions to improve an aspect of their community will be favored over other applicants.
