Thanksgiving with seniors- A long-standing Arcata event with a traditional Thanksgiving lunch with all the fixings is served. All seniors in the community are welcome!



We're made up of local business owners and managers, professionals, and civic leaders. We meet regularly, get to know each other, form friendships, and through that, we're able to get things done in our community.

Rotary is the oldest service organization in the world- a global network of community volunteers; an international organization with a very strong local community presence

More than 1.2 million men and women in over 200 countries and geographical areas belong to over 33,000 rotary clubs.

Rotary builds **international understanding** through scholarships, exchange programs, and humanitarian grants. Throughout the world, Rotary clubs participate in a broad range of educational, intercultural, and humanitarian activities to improve the lives of others.

#### **Benefits of Membership**

Members join Rotary for many reasons, including community involvement, personal development, professional networking, and camaraderie with fellow members. But perhaps the most important benefit is the satisfaction gained from making a real difference locally in our community, and in the world.

## **Local Rotary Club of Arcata Projects:**

**Arcata Playgrounds** – our club has played a major role in renovating and restoring several

playgrounds in underserved neighborhoods in our community.

Baylands Habitat Access and Restoration – We are working with the City of Arcata and conservation organizations to provide access and habitat to benefit wildlife.

High School Youth Exchange- We sponsor local students who go abroad, and students from diverse countries who attend school and experience life in Arcata. The program fosters goodwill and friendships worldwide and gives our future leaders an opportunity to grow.

**Arcata High Interact Club** - Affiliated with Rotary International, Interact provides service opportunities for high school students. We also support the school's Career Center.

**Boys and Girls Club building.** We help support renovation of this important facility.

**North Bay Rotaract-** We co-sponsor this club of 18-30 year old emerging professionals. They exchange ideas, develop professionally, and are involved with many service projects

**Dictionary Project-** We are part of a program that provides superior dictionaries to every 3<sup>rd</sup> grader in Humboldt County.

**Senior Thanksgiving Luncheon-** We serve traditional holiday fare to local senior citizens with help from the Interact Club.

**High School Scholarships**- We provide several education and vocational scholarships.

Micro-loans for women in Costa Rica- We are implementing a new project in a mountainous village, bringing sustainable economic development projects and improving educational and living opportunities for families. The project also includes

establishing Internet capability and rehabilitation of native forests.

Rotary Clubs from countries all over the world collaborate to create international projects that respond to community needs. Rotary Projects are designed to be sustainable and rely on the input of those in need to ensure the project is appropriate and will result in the best outcome.

Rotary International launched a **polio eradication** project in 1985. Since then, more than \$800 million has been raised by Rotary Clubs for vaccinations of more than 1 billion children. The number of polio cases *worldwide* was only 181 in 2012, and today is endemic in only two countries.
