TODAY'S SPEAKER

Mike Merrill introduced David Guhin, Assistant City Manager, City of Santa Rosa. He is an avid bike rider and for eight years has worked promote the Amgen Tour of California bike race. David told us that recruiting events in our town helps the city recoup some losses after the fires. During the Ironman competition, hotel rooms where full and restaurants were busy with visitors to our town. He talked a lot about our city's efforts to rebound from the fires. We had a housing problem before the fires and losing 3,000 homes to the fire just made it worse. The City has done a number of things to turn this around: a) Established website to show progress at each site b) Plans are turned around in 5 days c) Developed Housing Action Plan d) Advocating for housing downtown e) Downtown Specific Plan is being updated f) Trying to streamline the entire entitlement and permitting process g) Second units under 750sf are exempt from city fees David noted that 50% of the City's General Fund is from property taxes, so when there is fewer houses there is fewer dollars. The City is looking at their opportunity lots to increase housing stock to get units to accommodate all income ranges. We lost three hotels to the fire and the TRT monies they generated. Some proposals are already in process to build new hotels. There is also a Community Benefit District being proposed for the downtown area that can be used to help keep the safety and appearance maintained. After his talk he answered a number of questions.
