COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY Scholarship (\$2,000)

(Open to High School and Community College Students who will be attending a 4 year college/ university in the Fall)

Several <u>one-time scholarships</u> in the amount of \$1,000 and \$2,000 will be awarded by the Redwood City Rotary Club for the purpose of helping promising young men and women to continue their formal education.

To qualify for these scholarships, <u>applicants</u> (high school or junior college students) <u>MUST BE</u> <u>REDWOOD CITY RESIDENTS</u>.

The awards are based upon a number of criteria including:

- SCHOLASTIC ABILITY
- COMMUNITY SERVICE
- A SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY TOWARD EDUCATION
- FINANCIAL NEED

The awards are granted without regard to race, religion, creed, or national background. Other qualifications being equal, the Rotary Club prefers to assist the young men and women to whom the funds will mean the most in his or her pursuit of education. <u>Semifinalists will be contacted to schedule a personal interview</u> with the Redwood City Rotary Scholarship Committee in late March/early April. Awards will be presented at the Rotary luncheon in late May or early June.

<u>NOTE</u>: ALL PAGES OF THE APPLICATION MUST BE COMPLETED IN FULL BY APPLICANTS. We encourage students to attach additional pages to the application including lists of extracurricular activities and sports, awards and honors, work history and the like, which they may have already created as part of their college applications.



THE APPLICATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY:

- A TRANSCRIPT OF YOUR GRADES (complete High School transcript and Junior College transcripts, if applicable) AND
- A STATEMENT OF PURPOSE ESSAY.

IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBERS OF ROTARIANS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THESE SCHOLARSHIPS.

What is Rotary?

Rotary is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world. In more than 166 countries worldwide, approximately 1.2 million Rotarians belong to more than 34,000 Rotary clubs.

Rotary Club <u>membership</u> represents a cross-section of the community's business and professional men and women. The world's Rotary clubs meet weekly and are nonpolitical, nonreligious, and open to all cultures, races, and creeds.

The main objective of Rotary is service in the community, in the workplace, and throughout the world. Rotarians develop community service projects that address many of today's most critical issues, support education and job training, provide clean water, combat hunger, improve health and sanitation, and eradicate polio. They also support programs for youth, educational opportunities and international exchanges for students, teachers, and other professionals, and vocational and career development. The Rotary motto is <u>Service above Self</u>

Although Rotary Clubs develop autonomous service programs, all Rotarians worldwide are united in a campaign for the global eradication of polio. In the 1980s, Rotarians raised \$240 million to immunize the children of the world; by 2005, Rotary's centenary year and the target date for the certification of a polio-free world, the PolioPlus program contributed \$500 million to this cause. In addition, Rotary has provided an army of volunteers to promote and assist at national immunization days in polio-endemic countries around the world. In November 2007, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation joined the PolioPlus cause, pledging \$100 million which will be matched by Rotary International in a truly global partnership to finally eradicate this terrible disease.

Through Foundation grants Rotarians and other contributors can help change the world. They can finance a well for a village that lacks clean water, improve the environment, or provide



scholarships to educate the next generation. The grants and programs available to Rotarians allow them to realize Rotary's humanitarian mission throughout the world, including its number one goal of eradicating polio.

<u>The Rotary Foundation</u> of Rotary International is a not-for-profit corporation that promotes world understanding through international humanitarian service programs and educational and cultural exchanges. It is supported solely by voluntary contributions from Rotarians and others who share its vision of a better world. Since 1947, the Foundation has awarded more than US\$I.I billion in humanitarian and educational grants, which are initiated and administered by local Rotary clubs and districts.
