Magic and Demons in Ancient Egypt

Our speaker this week was Rita Lucarelli, Professor of Egyptology at UC Berkeley. Through a series of slides she demonstrated the importance of magic and demons in ancient Egyptian religion. Egyptian magic has often been viewed negatively, but it was

used in both religion and medicine. Often it took the form of an incantation or writing telling sick persons what to do to cure an illness.
