As a community leader, she chaired the City's July 4th Parade since 2016, and founded Concord's annual Art and Wine Walk. She is the former chair of Monument Impact, the Contra Costa Commission on the Status of Women, and past President of Soroptimist International of Diablo Vista.

Councilwoman said: "My priorities on the Board of Supervisors will build upon what I have prioritized on the Concord City Council: ensuring that our county government fixes our roads, expands access to affordable health care, creates opportunities for more supportive housing, protects our community, and nurtures the local economy to ensure all residents can live and work here."





Councilwoman Obringer has been active in many local organizations including the American Association of University Women-Concord Branch, the Concord Ambassadors, the Concord Historical Society, and the Greater Concord Chamber of Commerce. She holds a Master of Business Administration from the Monterey Institute of International Studies and resides in Concord with her husband, Justin, and their dog, Coco.
