To be considered by CVCSRC for the scholarship, the senior must complete this application, provide the other required information, and, most importantly, submit a 500-word essay on Rotary's Four-Way Test.

THE FOUR-WAY TEST ESSAY.

Rotarians have been committed to promoting high ethical standards in their professional lives. One of the worlds most widely printed and quoted statements of business ethics is the 4-Way Test, which Rotarian Herbert J Taylor created in 1932. Adopted by Rotary in 1943, the 4-Way Test has been translated into more than 100 languages and published in thousands of ways. It asks the following four questions requiring each individual to provide the answers:

Of the things we think, say, or do:

- 1. Is it the **TRUTH**?
- 2. Is it **FAIR** to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build **GOODWILL** and **BETTER FRIENDSHIPS**?
 - 4. Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?

The two subjects for the Four-Way Test essay that is to accompany this scholarship application are as follows:

- 1. Social media allows someone to post all sorts of things anonymously. How can the 4-Way Test help bring some responsibility and civility to any of the social media platforms?
- 2. Using a topic of your choice that incorporates the use of the Rotary 4-Way Test:

All submitted applications will be reviewed by the CVCSRC Scholarship Committee and finalists will be interviewed by the Committee members. The applicants will be judged based on criteria that includes, but is not limited to, the following: 1. Completeness of the application 2. Academic achievement 3. Extra-curricular activities, including community service activities and volunteering 4. Written and oral communication skills

The committee considers not simply your community service but, more importantly, the impact your service has had in the community. The committee considers volunteerism, service learning, fieldwork or internships that show civic responsibility and engagement.

All applicants will be notified of their status no later than the end of the school year.
