#### To the Fig Garden Rotary Board:

My name is Tara Paul and I have been accepted to be a volunteer with WordTeach, a non-profit organization that places volunteers as teachers in under-resourced schools in the developing world. I will be traveling to Chile in just under two months to teach English in a primary or secondary school through the Chilean Ministry of Education's *English Opens Doors* program. Knowledge of English is very important to Chile's development plans. For many students, it is required to find a job or qualify for higher education. By helping to improve the standard of English instruction, I can contribute to Chile's development, give students a better chance for their futures, and on a very small scale, help increase understanding and awareness on the part of Americans of this beautiful and deserving South American country.

In 2003, the Chilean Ministry of Education, realizing the significance of the ability to communicate in English in a globalizing world, took the initiative to establish the English Opens Doors (EOD) Program, an innovative program devoted to improving English teaching and learning in public schools throughout Chile. One of the program's primary features is the EOD Volunteer Program, which was founded in 2004 as a joint effort between the Ministry of Education and the United Nations Development Program-Chile. Since its founding, the EOD Volunteer Program has facilitated Chilean students' English language learning by giving them the chance to interact with a native speaker. The importance of this Program in contributing to Chile's future is evident from strong governmental backing from both the Ministry of Education and President Michelle Bachelet, who supports the EOD Volunteer Program through her Presidential Initiatives.

As with any volunteer project, there is a cost involved. I am very familiar with your leadership role in the Fresno Community through my father, Gordon Paul, and his longstanding membership. He has kindly offered to sponsor me in asking you to consider funding a portion of my costs. The cost of my placement, training, air travel, insurance and field support is almost \$5,000. My goal is to cover half of this amount through my own savings and the other half through the support of community based organizations such as yours.

I would be happy to attend one of your meetings to explain a little more about the program and my reasons for needing assistance. I would also be happy to give a presentation at one of your meetings upon my return from my teaching assignment overseas or send you a newsletter while abroad.

Thank you for considering my request. I would be very grateful for your support and know that I would make you proud of your investment.
