1. Organization Status

- Is your organization a 501(c)(3), tax-exempt organization? (No grants will be made to individuals or for-profit organizations.)

2. Grant Priorities (check one)

- Does your program benefit youth and educational activities serving the youth of Monterey and the surrounding Peninsula?
OR
 Does your program benefit the underserved and disabled adult population of Monterey and the surrounding Peninsula?

If you checked one box in #1 and #2 above, you meet our initial criteria. The next step is to complete the rest of this application and follow the submission instructions at the bottom of the application.
