The history of the organization of this club is briefly as follows:

On November 16, 1921 Mr. Homer T Hayward of Salinas, Calif., was appointed Chairman of the Organizing Committee for the proposed Rotary Club of Salinas. In accordance with the usual form as laid down by International Rotary the organizing Committee was selected and after the proper meetings the 17 charter members selected.

On April 29th, 1922, thirty members of the Rotary Club of San Jose journeyed to Salinas whereupon Salinas club was duly organized.

This club has adopted the standard constitution prescribed by the Association for local clubs. (Certified copy attached.)

This club has a satisfactory charter list of members as is indicated by the list attached to its application.


This club has duly elected its members.
