

Eligibility Guidelines

To enroll in this WIA program, youth must meet **ALL** of these requirements.

- 17-21 years old
- Senior status at enrollment
- Low Income - Based on family size. Income guidelines are available on the referral sheet.
- Reside in SLO County.
- Men must have registered for selective service at age 18.
- Must be authorized to work in the U.S.
- Barrier to employment or education including:
 - Basic Skills Deficient
 - English Language Learner
 - Homeless/Runaway
 - Offender
 - Foster Youth
 - Parenting/Pregnant
 - IEP/504 plan
 - Other significant barriers may qualify. Please check with Career Coach.

Classes and training may be held during school hours, after-school hours and/or during the summer.
