TWIN PEAKS ROTARY

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP POLICY

An individual may become an eligible Corporate Member of Longmont Twin Peaks Rotary through our regular member approval process.

Membership would have one primary member that would receive:

- Rotary International and District recognition as the member
- Formal induction into the club
- Voting member of the club
- Can hold any office in the club
- Rotary magazine
- All Rotary International, District & club emails and notices
- Recognition on all Rotary member lists and website
- Access to the Rotary website
- Would include the cost of all lunches they attend
- Rotary member badge

Cost of Corporate Membership will be \$250/quarter plus a one-time initiation fee of \$74.00.

Corporate Membership may have up to 2 additional designees.

- These designees will be specifically named and can be anyone from the same corporation.
- Any of the 2 designees can attend any Rotary meeting, and are encouraged to participate in fundraisers, service projects and socials.
- If the primary member does not attend lunch, one of the 2 designees will receive that primary member's lunch for free.
- Any other attendees at the same meeting will pay the lunch fee of \$12.00 (or whatever the current fee is) every time they attend a lunch.
- The named designees will receive the club newsletter, notices and a membership badge.

Any designee can join the club as an individual member at any time. Regular membership fees and initiation fees will be charged.

Process of termination of a Corporate membership primary member or designee will be the same as a regular member.
