ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### ORO VALLEY ROTARY FOUNDATION

KNOW ALL PEOPLE BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, the undersigned, has this day purposed the forming of a non-profit corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Arizona and for that purpose do hereby adopt these Articles of Incorporation.

#### ARTICLE I

NAME: The name of the corporation shall be: ORO VALLEY ROTARY FOUNDATION.

#### ARTICLE II

The name and address of the incorporator is:

# ARTICLE III

PURPOSE: The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which a non-profit corporation may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Arizona including, but not limited to, receiving gifts and grants of money of property, or interests therein, of every kind and character, and to administer and distribute same, or the income thereon and which is consistent with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as they be amended from time to time.

#### ARTICLE IV

The corporation is exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including transactions with those that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).

#### ARTICLE V

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or: (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws).

#### ARTICLE VI

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of its assets exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purpose as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws) as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.

#### ARTICLE VII

To the extent allowed by the Arizona Revised Statutes Sections 10-2305 Al8 and 10-2342 A8, the personal liability of a director to the corporation or its members for monetary damages for the breach of fiduciary duty as a director shall be eliminated.

#### ARTICLE VIII

The power of indemnification under the Arizona Revised Statutes shall not be denied or limited by the bylaws of the

The corporation shall, to the extent permitted by corporation. Arizona Revised Statutes Section 10-2305 C as they may be amended from time to time, indemnify any member, director, officer, employee, or agent of the corporation who incurs liability or expenses by reason of his or her acting the capacity of a member; director, officer, employee, or agent of the corporation.

- The corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner so that it will not become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax coda.
- The corporation will not engage in an act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or
- corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

  3. The corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

  4. The corporation will not make any investments in a manner
- that would subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal

Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

5. The corporation will not make any taxable expanditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
