- **Training workshops** for services to the Homebound, Nursing Home, Hospital, & Prison Ministries.
  - **Collaborate with hospitals** to create/maintain visitation teams
- **Advance Care Planning** training workshops
- **Prison Ministry** inside facilities providing Mass, Communion Services, Sacrament Preparation and Bible Studies.
- **Reentry Services** support with transitioning from prison to life outside of prison. Assistance with one month of transitional housing fees.

# 2024 Year in Review

We served over **100,000** people in direct support through our programs and services.

**15,232** nights of shelter provided to **474** adults and children

**3,632** hours of counseling for **3,434** children and adults

**15,922** free tax returns filed resulting in **\$14,512,685** in refunds to low-income families

**168,460** hours of residential support given to individuals with disabilities

**387** families received housing and utility support

**247,460** nutritious meals provided to **2,133** seniors and adults with disabilities

**4,433** hours of supportive services given to **317** Deaf and DeafBlind clients

**131** children and **36** families received support through our foster care programs
