Budget: \$79,082 USD

This vital project seeks to improve the health and well-being of the community of Yarumela and its surroundings. This will be achieved through the installation of latrines, water storage units, water filters, and hygiene training.

Installing 100 Letrines, 100 Water Storage Pilas and 125 Water Filters





Project Progress



23 washable latrines out of the planned 100 have been installed. Additionally, 50 latrines have been manufactured..



14 water storage units (pilas) out of the planned 100 have already been installed.



76 water filters are already in use. The total of 125 required water filters has been purchased.

Manufacturing of Pour Flush Letrines





Progress in latrine manufacturing is crucial for the project. 50 units have already been produced, bringing us closer to the goal of 100. This local process generates employment and strengthens the community.



Investment in Water Filters

The acquisition of the 125 filters is a key achievement. These filters will ensure safe drinking water for many families, promoting health and preventing disease.

Impact of Hygiene Training







Training is essential to ensure the proper use of the new facilities. It promotes healthy hygiene habits and helps prevent disease.


 Regarding water and sanitation, 47% of the impoverished population lack access to clean water, which is 13% lower than the previous year, according to the United Nations

- 1.Complete the installation of latrines, Pilas, and filters.
- 2. Continue with hygiene training.
- 3. Supervise the use and maintenance of the filters.
- 4. Finish the first phase
