Some notes: We will be asking Long Realty Cares and PICOR to partner with us in The Dictionary Project again this year. Any project that goes through a 501c3 can be paid with our Provision Bridge account funds. Any surplus funds we have allows us to consider Lend a Hand requests from \$300-\$500. The * indicates Kino's signature service projects. Fortunately, there are some service projects that do not impact the budget: Park cleanup, volunteering at the Community Foodbank or at the Diaper Bank, sponsoring vocational students and Peace Fellowships. Donations to PolioPlus and the Rotary Foundation wash through the club and do not fall under service projects. **Also, feel free to add any project ideas you may have for Kino to consider taking on or any comments about your priority choices at the bottom of the list.** This should only take a few minutes of your time, so please try to submit it by August 2nd. And let's all pitch in to make the golf tournament successful so that we can do it all!
