Virtual Youth Exchange

We are expanding our Youth Exchange Program to enable more of our District 5630 high school students to participate. This Pilot Program will be a collaboration with **Rotary District 3190**, with more than 90 Rotary Clubs in southern India.



How does it work?

From January 8 through February 26, 2022 (8 weeks), 6 students from Nebraska and 6 students from Karnataka will meet virtually on Saturdays at 8:00 a.m. CST (7:00 a.m. MST) in the U.S. and 7:30 p.m. IST in India. Our initial program will include high students ages 15 and 16.

At each 90-minute session, students will discuss such topics as language, music, art, traditions, food, climate, school and daily life, sports, and entertainment.

Each session will cover a different topic and consist of an introduction, presentation, breakout discussions, and wrap-up. A moderator and/or resource person from each district will be present in the breakout rooms.

The program will strictly abide by the Rotary International Youth Protection Guide.
