Downtown Construction Parking


In addition to parking on First and Second Street, Hudson offers several other options you can use during your visit.



Historic charm and stunning scenery are two defining characteristics of Hudson, Wisconsin. Come visit us and experience special attractions, book a private tour, and enjoy walking tours that lead to our historic downtown. Our main street area is full of unique shops and award-winning restaurants. Many downtown buildings were built between 1860 and 1880 and have been restored to their original grandeur. Third Street includes the "grand dames" of Hudson's historic homes including the historic Octagon House Museum.




