The following eligibility criteria apply to IMAGINE PEACE PROJECTS:

Eligibility of project concept:

Design and implement peace projects on the United Nations International Day of Peace on September 21, 2022. Create awareness of International Day of Peace and promote peace in your community. Your project should encourage the inclusion of young people in peace-building at the local level. It may promote peace-building through one of the seven areas of Rotary International: Promoting peace | Fighting disease | Providing clean water, sanitation, and hygiene | Saving mothers and children | Supporting education | Growing local economies | Protecting the environment.

Examples of Projects:

- Host art/music/poetry event with the theme of peace
- Plan an event collaboratively with diverse groups
- Use music, performance, poetry, comedy, or storytelling to raise awareness of issues or imagining peaceful futures
- Share food & culture in public space
- Organize a joint Peace project with a community group
- Organize an on-line social media campaign to promote peace in society/peaceful relations
- Start a mural or community art project

- Make fleece blankets for children in foster care system
- Use sports to bring people together

Take pictures, create short videos! Record the history you are making!

Eligibility of project holder:

- Any District 6060 affiliated group as identified in paragraph one.
- Project endorsement should be from the leadership of the group
- Only one application per club or group may be submitted.
- Application signed by person overseeing the project and funds and the Club president.

A PEACE GIFT of up to \$500 may be awarded for your project.

The application must:

- Be fully completed including budget and club/group endorsement.
- Demonstrate convincingly the relevance of the project's objectives and activities in relation to actions for peace.

IMAGINE PEACE PROJECT FINAL REPORT must be completed and submitted to the district.
