How We Spent the District Designated Grant

Community Assistance Project Grants to Rotary Clubs in District 6060: \$30,472

Twenty-nine clubs received CAP grants to complete 34 local projects valued at \$83,872.

Club-Initiated International Projects: \$5000

Eight clubs received matching grant funds and partnered with Rotarians in the host countries to complete humanitarian projects in the Dominican Republic, Guatemala, and Ethiopia.

Cultural Exchange with District 4945: \$1630

Eight clubs were involved in hosting the Cultural Exchange Team from the bi-national District 4945 in Argentina/Uruguay.

District Ambassadorial Scholarship: \$25,000

Awarded to Whitney Richardson to study physical therapy at Southwest Baptist University.

Donation to Polio Plus: \$30,424

Donation to Peace Scholar Program: \$25,000

Having contributed \$25K every year to the Peace Scholar Program since its inception, District 6060 is recognized as a Peace Builder District.

Support of Global Grants around the world: \$68,000

We supported Rotary projects in 10 countries valued at \$1.5 million. The District 6060 contribution to these projects was matched 1-1 by the World Fund of The Rotary Foundation. One of these projects was the Mexico Education Grant. Thirty-four of our clubs donated at least \$4 per member for this Global Grant.
