## Dog Show Rules and Regulations

1. All dog owners must show proof of current rabies vaccinations for registered dog upon arriving at check-in.
2. Dogs must be at least 6 months old to enter the show.
3. Dogs must be kept on leads at ALL times. Maximum length no longer than 6'. **Retractable leads are not acceptable.** IF YOUR DOG IS LET OFF THE LEAD YOU MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE EVENT.
4. Dog owners must clean up after their dogs. Please bring your own dog waste bags. There will be a bin provided around the event area to dispose bags.
5. The safety and well being of all animals at the event is the responsibility of their owners. Owners must keep their dog under control always.
6. Dog owners will be responsible for any damage or harm caused to property, people or other animals made by their dogs.
7. You your family friends and pets enter the event field at your own risk. The Rotary Club of Cottleville/Weldon Spring Rotary, its Board of Directors, staff, volunteers or its sponsors and the City of Cottleville will not be held responsible for any accident or incident that may occur.
8. The Rotary Club of Cottleville/Weldon Spring, its Board of Directors, staff, volunteers or its sponsors, and the City of Cottleville will not be responsible for any damage or harm caused by your dogs to you, other people, or other dogs.
9. Any dog that bites a human or another animal will be immediately disqualified. The owner of the aggressive animal and complainant will need to fill out a police report. The owner and dog must then leave the park.
10. Since this is a charity event, dog show entry fees and class fees are non-refundable.
11. If you have entered your dogs into the dog show it is your responsibility to listen for announcements of the class times and start times.
12. Dog show entries will be limited to fewer than 30 per class. This is for the safety of you, your animals, spectators, and all people involved in the show.
13. If you find or lose anything, please report to the registration desk.
14. Adverse weather conditions. The organizers have the right to shut down part or the entire event in the event of adverse weather conditions. Since this is a charity event, entry fees and show tickets are non-refundable.
15. Any aggressive or constantly barking dog will be asked to leave without a refund.
16. Winners: There will be awards for the winner in each group. All 1<sup>st</sup> place winners will compete in the Best of Show and Crow Favorite category.
