# How to be Resilient in the Face of Challenges - Wellness for Warriors, Adm. Hank Moliengo

Hank Molinengo is a volunteer with Wellness for Warriors (WForW). He served 28 years in the Navy as



a judge advocate. As a lawyer in the Navy, he served with all warfare specialties, including an extended tour at sea. Hank was in the Pentagon on 9-11 and saw firsthand the bravery and dedication of the first responders who came to their aid. At the time of his retirement as a Rear Admiral, he was the Assistant Judge Advocate General of the Navy respon-

sible for the support and wellbeing of 800 JAG officers, 400 civilian attorneys, 500 enlisted and 1000 staff worldwide. After his retirement in 2008, he served as a civilian attorney with the Department of Navy for 9 months. Later, from August 2009 to January 2021, he served as the Senior Associate Dean for Administrative Affairs with The George Washington University Law School (GW Law), the fifth largest law school in the country, where he was responsible for community wellness, among other matters. In January 2021 he retired from this position, but remains an adjunct professor with GW Law. He moved to Springfield, MO with his wife Fran to be close to his daughter, son-in-law and5 grandchildren.

Desiring to pay it forward, in March 2021 he became a volunteer with Wellness for Warriors, and currently serves as a facilitator and chair of the Advisory Board. He cares deeply about the mission of WForW given his own experience in dealing with the stress of military service.
