Rotary on the Road @ the SGF Airport

On Tuesday, August 29th we will have a joint lunch meeting with Sunrise Rotary at the Springfield-Branson National Airport (large hanger just south of the former airline terminal on the east side of the airport), 5000 W. Kearney at noon.

Members will be given a rare opportunity to see a B-29, B-24 and T-6 up close and personal. After a short opening from the two Club Presidents and welcome from the Director of Aviation, the main program will be a presentation from a Commemorative Air Force Pilot on what is involved in keeping these WWII aircrafts flying and what it is like to actually fly them. Time will be allotted for Q&A with an opportunity to conclude the meeting with a walk around the historic aircrafts.

Jeremy Lashbrook lives in Cabot, AR with his wife and 2 children on a hobby farm. Jeremy is retired from the Arkansas Army National Guard where he spent a 26-year career as a Helicopter and Airplane pilot. Jeremy currently operates his own aviation business as a Designated Pilot Examiner and flies as an EMS helicopter pilot for Arkansas Children's Hospital. Jeremy is a 3rd generation pilot and has a passion for WWII aircraft. He holds an FAA Airframe and Power Plant Mechanic Certificate as well as an Airline Transport Pilot Certificate for both Airplanes and Helicopters. He holds an Experimental Authorization to fly the B-29 Superfortress and B-24 Liberator. Jeremy also flies the PT-13 Stearman and T-6 Texan on the Commemorative Air Force Air Power History Tour.
