1. Set up a PayPal account by downloading the app on your phone or visiting [paypal.com](https://www.paypal.com)

3. Enter the amount you would like to send
4. Select “friends and family” as the payment type, so that the club does not get charged any fees
5. If you are asked to verify the first and last name enter “Springfield” as first name and “Rotary” as last name
6. You will then select how you would like to pay (bank account or credit/debit card). If you choose to send money directly from your bank account

using your routing and account number there is no fee
