Climate Change Questions Answered: Is Climate Change Happening in Missouri Now? Will Missouri be Too Hot in 20 Years? Is This All a Hoax?, Toby Dogwiler

Toby's training lies at the intersection of hydrology, geomorphology, and climatology with



some soil science, stream ecology, and geospatial science thrown in for good measure. His research investigates the effect of interactions between hydrology, climate, and land use on water resources and

conservation issues. Currently, he is using imagery acquired with drones to investigate these questions. Toby has co-authored over 80 technical reports, conference presentations, and peer-reviewed journal articles. Over the past two decades, he has collaborated with local, state, federal, and private organizations on numerous projects in the Driftless Area of Minnesota and the Ozarks in southern Missouri. Much of this work has involved undergraduate and graduate students and provided them with hands-on experiences that have led many of them into their own water resources and conservation-related careers. One of the things he loves about this work is that he is constantly learning from his collaborators and the landowners with which they work. When not working, Toby enjoys spending time with his family and traveling. His hobbies are competitive cycling and running. He loves to compete and currently holds two running records in Missouri and a state championship bike racing.
