Fred Hall and Doug Kays

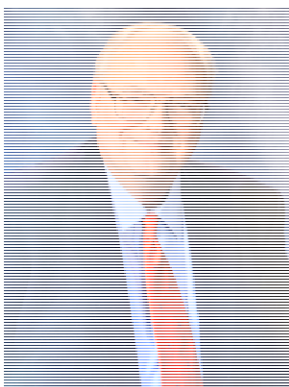
Presidential impeachment is the subject of recent books and political wrangling. But what has been



our country's history in dealing with the issue of presidential impeachment? Fred Hall and Doug Kays have done a study of the subject to explain the history and the law surrounding the topic.

Fred Hall grew up in southeast Missouri-Kennett. After graduating

from high school in 1945, he spent a little over a year in the U. S. Navy, during WWII. Upon returning home, he attended the University of



Missouri-Columbia where he received a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science, a law degree, and a master's degree in finance from the business school. Upon graduation he came to Springfield and practiced law for over 58 years; taught at Drury University as an

adjunct professor for 15 years and at Missouri State University for five years.

Doug Kays, also a retired Springfield attorney, graduated from the University of Missouri-Kansas City with a Bachelor of Arts in History and a law degree. He was in private practice from 1972-

1980; then served as executive director of Legal Services of Southern Missouri from 1980-2015.
