### Conquering Your Mountain

Craig Henley is a former Member and Board Member of Springfield Metro Rotary. He recently



returned from a Mission Trip to Uganda with the local non-profit, Man Up and Go. While in Africa, he and a group of 12 other men, all representing Man Up and Go, climbed Mt. Kilimanjaro, the highest peak in Africa and the highest free-standing mountain in the world

at 19,341 feet. Their goal was to raise awareness for the 153 million orphans worldwide.

Craig's story is one of overcoming the physical and mental challenges of the climb, while enjoying the emotional and spiritual experience of being on Kilimanjaro. His talk, entitled "Conquering Your Mountain" highlights the opportunities we each have as we tackle our own "mountains."

Craig is married to Dr. Kimberly Henley, an ER Physician at Mercy Hospital. They have been in Springfield since 2008 and will be celebrating 23 years of marriage this October. They have 3 boys; Braden, a Sophomore at Springfield Catholic High School, and twins, Dawson and Dylan, 6<sup>th</sup> Graders at Immaculate Conception School. Craig is a Board Member for Man Up and Go. He founded and serves as a Board Member of Sprout Business Group. Craig also serves as Grand Knight for the Immaculate Conception Knights of Columbus, a Catholic Men's Organization. Craig was recently named one of SBJ's Most Trusted Advisers for 2019.
