Reconstruction components of MHC's mission. Specifically, Greg oversees MHC's role in the heritage tourism initiative known as the U. S. Grant Trail and in the annual U. S. Grant Symposium. Greg is also Executive Director of Missouri's Civil War Heritage Foundation

and author of 2010s *Friend and Foe Alike: A Tour Guide to Missouri's Civil War*, an exhaustive treatment of 235 Civil War sites across Missouri.

Ashley's duties as Associate Director include development, advocacy, and management. She is



charged with the development of the Springfield and Kansas City regions, which entails extensive stakeholder outreach, collaboration with partners, and expanding Missouri Humanities' presence in local communities. Previously,

Ashley served as the Executive Director of American Public Square. Prior to that role, she conducted research, program evaluation, and community assessments for institutions such as the Ewing Marion Kauffman Foundation and the City of Kansas City's Health Commission, and UMKC's Public Affairs Department. Ashley has worked for various nonprofit organizations throughout her career including the UMKC Foundation, Missouri Jobs with Justice, and Mother's Refuge with much of her focus on fundraising and development. Currently, Ashley serves as Treasurer of the Board of Directors for Hope Haven, Cass County's domestic violence shelter, and on Missouri's Division of Youth Services Advisory Board.
