

## Final Instructions to Students

Be on time and plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled interview time.

**Be sure to bring a complete hard copy of your application.** This will be collected at check-in and will be reviewed while you are completing your interview rotation. We will provide the necessary signatures and you will be advised if we find anything missing or if we think anything should be re-done.

When you check in, you will be given your interview routing schedule. Wait in the meeting room until you have been directed to go to your first interview station. When directed to do so, go to the interview station indicated on the card and wait outside the door until you are invited in.

When you enter the room, the team leader will introduce the interview panel. You should state your name, where you are from and then take a seat.

You will be asked a wide variety of questions, which you should try to answer as clearly and as quickly as possible. You may be asked to expand on some of your responses. Or you may be cut-off on some of your responses if the panelists think you have answered the question sufficiently and want to move on to the next question.

When the "timer" knocks on the door, this will be the indicator that there is ONE MINUTE remaining to wrap up your comments.

When your time is up, leave the room and move on to your next station. Stand outside the door until you are invited in.....and the process will begin again.

After you have visited all of the interview stations, you should return to the meeting room, connect with your parents and leave.

Finally, try not to be nervous. Most of the panelists have been involved in the RYE Program for many years and **ALL of them want you to have a successful interview.**
