**INFORMATION SHEET**

**WHAT:**

This is a **FREE** public event where area Sand Springs nonprofit organizations have the opportunity to showcase their organization's public-invited programs, events, and activities, as well as, the services they provide for Sand Springs residents.

**PURPOSE/GOALS:**

1. Increase public awareness and attention about the various Sand Springs area nonprofit organizations. (e.g. Their mission, goals, work/projects/events available for the public to attend, as well as, opportunities for citizens to volunteer their time.)
2. Increase public awareness about the various opportunities within the Sand Springs area nonprofit organizations for citizens to receive services, funding and/or scholarships.
3. Attract new members/volunteers who desire to become involved in a service-oriented organization that fulfills his/her aspirations for personal and community service. (e.g. Membership drive)

**EVENT DATE/TIME:**

**EVENT STRUCTURE:**

Sand Springs Area Nonprofit organizations who conduct public-invited programs, events, and activities, and/or who provide various types services to Sand Springs residents will be invited to participate. They will have a table display about their organization's informational brochures and materials. Chairs will be provided for their representatives to sit.

**PRIZES:**

Though not required, it is requested that each participating nonprofit provide one door prize used to entice citizens to attend the event. We suggest a minimum value of \$15.00 which could be in the form of a gift certificate or event ticket package or something of that nature. In addition, Sand Springs businesses will be asked to provide prizes. Last year, we had some GREAT prizes.

This year, each door prize will be numbered. Participants will go to each table and get a ticket. When a certain number of tickets have been collected, the adult person will come to the "**Rotary Spinner**" and spin for a prize. In this matter, prizes will be distributed throughout the evening. Children will have a Kids Zone where they can participate in some activity and receive a prize.

## **FREE FOOD:**

A free hot dog or hamburger and a drink will be available (while supplies) last.

## **NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION EVENT SET-UP:**

The Rotary Club will provide:

- A table (if you do not have one) and chair(s) for your organization.
- One sign at the table to identify the name of your organization.
- Food and drink (while supplies last) and a drawing for door prizes for those attending. (Representatives from the organizations are invited to participate in prizes, too.)
- A directory of "Fast Facts About Sand Springs Nonprofits" will be available to all attendees.

The Nonprofit organization will provide:

- Materials about your organization. (Mission, Purpose/Goals, Membership information)
- Printed calendars to announce the date, time, and place for your 2017-2018 public invited programs, events/activities.
- The name and contact information of a person in your organization who can provide your organization's "Fast Facts" information for the directory.
- Market/post the "Nonprofit Showcase" flier on your website and announce it to your members at meetings. Display a poster at your site or member businesses. Together we can encourage persons to attend. (**Free Food - Free Prizes**)
