

Dear Members of Southeast Rotary,

I am writing this letter on behalf of students at Clark Elementary to request \$5,000 for after school programs. As districts across the state have been burdened to make major budget cuts, our responsibilities as a community school continue to grow. We are still charged with helping meet the academic, emotional, and social needs of our students and their families. With virtually no state, federal, and district funds allocated to enrichment programs during after school hours, we are seeking funding to sustain programs upon which hundreds of students and parents depend. Nearly 65% of students in grades kindergarten through five participate in at least one after school program at Clark.

When the final bell rings and the school day comes to an end, it marks the beginning of an unsupervised and unstructured time for many children. Research and data show that afterschool programming has tremendous benefits for children. While after school programs provide a safe and structured place for our students, they also provide engaging, hand-on opportunities for youth development that complement the school day. Clark staff and community partners work together to mentor and teach our students in much smaller groups compared to the school day, and as a result, students gain valuable social, academic, and professional skills.

Students from higher income families spend their after school hours engaged in activities such as music lessons, dance, sports, tutoring, among others. Parents choose to pay for these extracurricular activities because they understand the value they bring to their child's education, and the important life lessons and skills they gain as a result. We believe all students, regardless of parent income, deserve such opportunities.

Our goal, with support from Southeast Rotary, is to give students at Clark the opportunity for high-quality enrichment programs in safe, nurturing afterschool environments. This will result in children having a greater sense of belonging in their school communities, increased school attendance and achievement, and a brighter, more positive view of themselves and their potential in life.

With your help, Clark can maintain its after school program offerings. Thank you for considering our request. We are grateful to Rotary's continued support of our educational and enrichment efforts at Clark


