## MSSU Biology Pond

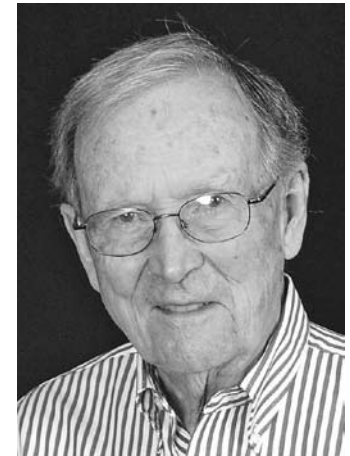

Did you know the Biology Pond on campus is actually a wetland and not a pond at all?

It is like a continually filling and draining bathtub. The water source comes from a below-ground spring that is holding a toasty warm temperature of 62.6 F. The physical geography of the area and chemical properties of water allows a very unique thing to happen on campus. This wetland never freezes!

It was -15°F Tuesday night (the coldest temperature on record for Joplin) and the wetland is STILL holding a high temp of 62.6F.

Yesterday, Dr. David Penning and Jeremiah Cline (his research student) were documenting use of the pond by birds and taking water temperature data.

According to Dr. Penning, this whole wetland is essentially a geothermally powered water source that should maintain a fairly constant temperature throughout the year. Because of this constant heat, many animals are likely using this to stay warm in these extreme weather conditions.

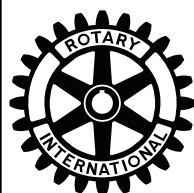
They hope to continue to monitor the wetland as they work to restore the habitat of the region!
