**Emcee - Mike Mims**



A student under Coach Lacy and graduate of Booker T Washington High School (BTW) basketball coach Mike Mims spent 13 years coaching and leading the Hornets to three state championships. Achievements includes assistant coach at U of Oklahoma, assistant principal at BTW, Tulsa Public Schools Hall of Fame, and *Sports Illustrated* 1988 Assistant Coach of the Year. When Mayor G.T. Bynum dedicated a street in his name, Mims said of his legendary career, ““Help these kids survive out in the real world. To go to college, to have a family, to have kids, to face their responsibilities. Those are the things that I try to teach as a coach.”

**Coach Edward “Ed” Lacy**, a legendary coach, mentor, and community leader served Booker T. Washington High School for 17 years, leading the football, track, tennis, swimming, and wrestling teams. Coach Lacy led the Hornets to state high school football championships five times and was later named the Athletic Director for Tulsa Public Schools. He served as a devoted volunteer for the YMCA (active board member since 1960). He was inducted into the Tulsa Historical Hall of Fame, 1995, and the Oklahoma Coaches Association Hall of Fame, 1980.
