Your donation can be made to either of the funds, but we are asking for your contribution to be made to the Annual Fund Share. Here is how that contribution will benefit Rotary around the world.

The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund Share

When you give to the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund Share program, your dollars are spent both here at home and all over the world to fund projects that promote the mission of the Rotary Foundation: "to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty". When you give to the Annual Fund Share program, the money you give is invested for three years. At the end of the three years, the money is divided with 50% returning to the District (called "District Designated Funds" or "DDF" for short) and 50% going to the "World Fund". The 50% coming back to the District (DDF) can be used to support the polio eradication effort, to fund a global grant, to support the Rotary Peace centers, and to fund projects in our District.

Money used to fund projects in our District are called "District Grants". For a District Grant, the local Rotary club selects a community service project and submits a grant application to the District for funding. The total value of all District Grants in a one year period cannot exceed 50% of that year's allocation of DDF.

The World Fund is the primary source of matching funds for global grant projects all over the world. If the District uses some of its DDF to fund a 'global grant', the District can match the global grant DDF, dollar for dollar, with World Fund money.

Your donations to the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund share program make a difference because they help those who need it the most. More than 90 percent of donations go directly to supporting sustainable service projects both here at home and around the world. Your contributions can save a life and make the world a better place.

This offer begins now and expires March 31, 2020. Make sure your checks <u>arrive</u> well BEFORE March 31, 2020. We can match only the first \$22,000 in donations we receive.

- Paul Harris Fellowships and pins will require 1-2 months to arrive.
- You will receive an emailed receipt letter from The Rotary Foundation approximately 2-3 weeks after we receive your check.
- Your receipt will only be for the amount of your check, since we are providing "the match" with Foundation Recognition Points.
- Donations made online at rotary.org, sent directly to The Rotary Foundation, or coming from a Rotary Club Check will not be matched only those donations submitted via the steps listed above.
