Rotary District 6200 Hurricane Disaster Relief Effort

The Rotary District 6200 Hurricane Disaster Relief Effort was established to assist the individuals and communities impacted by Hurricanes Laura and Delta.

The fund is a restricted 501 (c) 3 fund maintained by the Rotary International District 6200 Foundation, Inc. The funds in this account can only be released by approval of the Rotary International District 6200 Foundation, Inc. Trustees. The funds will only be spent on projects to provide relief to individuals and communities impacted by Hurricane Laura in August 2020 and Hurricane Delta in October 2020.

The funds' priorities will be families & children, senior citizens, economic development for small enterprises, and/or similar programs.

Criteria for the Rotary District 6200 Hurricane Disaster Relief Effort:

1. Local Rotary Clubs in Rotary District 6200 must be involved.
2. Matching requests would be favorable wherever possible.
3. Any questions must be answered before final approval, but approval in principle may be provided, pending certain additional information.
4. Projects can be worked in phases with the distribution of dollars as needed during each of the phases. The next phase only gets disbursement of funds once a report of the first phase is submitted and accepted.
5. Final Stewardship Reports and Photos are due no later than thirty (30) days after completing the project.
6. Records will be kept on all submissions, whether approved or not approved.
