- Time: 4:30 – 10:00 pm Grillers set-up opens at 1:00 pm Gates to the public at 4:00 pm
- Place: Southdown's Buquet Pavilion & Grounds
- Team Size: Teams of 6 are accepted in registration. Each team must have two servers. Fees include aprons, wristband and six (6) drink tickets per person.
- Entry Fee: \$250.00 per team of 6. **ROTARIAN TEAM DISCOUNT - \$200.00 PER TEAM.**
- Space Size: 30 - Trailer pull-up are supplied an 18' x 30' space which includes supplied tent.  
6 - Tent spaces are supplied a 10' x 14' space which includes supplied tent.
- Needed Items: Competitors need to supply 50-75 burgers, cut into quarters (1/4) for sampling (200-250 samples).

Team Members will have to check in and wear their pre-issued wristbands. **NO PETS and NO SMOKING** are allowed on the grounds of Southdown Plantation.

Clean up area is provided in the Pavilion kitchen. **ALL** teams will clean up their booth spaces, empty garbage in provided receptacles and exit the premise with their equipment by 11:00 pm.

No outside beverages are allowed on festival grounds. Beverages will be provided by our naming sponsor.
