## Gull Lake Area Rotary Club Grant Guidelines for Unallocated Funds

## September 1, 2023

- 1. Grant requests are submitted via the Grant Application Form and referred to the Grant Committee.
- 2. If recommended by the Committee, the Grant Application Forms is then submitted to the Board of the Gull Lake Area Rotary Club (GLARC) for their approval.
- 3. The GLARC grants should support local community projects.
- 4. Club members should not submit applications on behalf of an organization, but the organization should make the request.
- 5. Grants cannot benefit an individual but should impact as many people as possible.
- 6. Grant requests from 501 © 3 organizations are preferred.
- 7. No Rotarians or their family members can benefit from the grant.
- 8. Grants should be for specific projects or needs or scholarships and not go to a general fund.
- 9. Grant recipients must submit the written Completed Project Report within one month of the end of the project describing how monies were spent and the impact of the donation.
- 10. If the project is canceled or not completed, the funds will return to the Club.
