Combined Meeting of the Boards of the Portage Rotary Club and Portage Rotary Charities

A combined meeting of the Boards of Directors of the Portage Rotary Club and of Portage Rotary Charities ("Charities") was held on October 27, 2017 at Michelle's Restaurant in Portage, and was called to order at 7:30 a.m. by President Dave Jewell.

Present: Board members present were: Dave Jewell, Chris Buckley, Jim Martin, Tom Welsh (10/4), Dan Melnik (10/11), Bill Beck (10/25), Gary Meyers, Jeannine Willacker, Phil Stinchcomb (10/18), Erica McCulley, and Patrick Song (10/18). Also present: Mike Simon. (Makeup dates)

Minutes: Secretary Bill presented Minutes of the meeting of the Boards held on September 27, 2017 which had been previously been sent by email to all of members of the Boards for their comments. After discussion, MMSP that the Minutes be approved as presented.

Secretary's Report: Secretary Bill reported that membership is down to 68 Active (not counting Honorary and Rule of 85) total. One more subtraction this month with the notification that Carl (Chip) Schelb will not renew his membership, indicating a possible move to the Kalamazoo Rotary.. After discussion, MMSP that the resignation of Chip is accepted with regrets, albeit with a request to co-secretaries to develop a clearer policy on membership dues payments. Bill also commented on the need to "clean up" our club database as there are many discrepancies between our data and that of Rotary International in the DaCdb. A request will be sent to members to review their data for accuracy. After discussion, MMSP that the Secretary's Report be approved.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Dan reported that the General Fund was stable with certain elements fluctuating slightly (see attached financial reports). Dan reported that one drain on resources is lunch expense. We are contracted with Michelle's to provide 43 paid meals per meeting, but our monthly average is only 40 paid lunches. Discussion about raising the \$2 fee for fasting members to \$5. No action taken as yet. After discussion, MMSP that the financial statements as of September 30, 2017 be accepted as presented.

President's Report: President Dave presented a suggestion to hold a 5:01 meeting as a community service event. No program or project was confirmed, just floated idea to get boards reaction. Future 5:01 dates will be in November, January and May. Dave also brought up the need for a policy in place for members who don't pay on time or pay in installments. It was referred to secretary. See secretary report. Dave advised the board of Community Service award going to five members, \$100 donation to charity of their choosing. He also discussed corporate plan to recruit new members, it was determined to contact Kalamazoo Club for their plan and tweek for our own club.

President Elect's Report: President-elect Chris presented feedback from surveys to members attending less than 50% of the time.

Other Business: Gary Meyers presented grant request by Jim Martin on behalf of Portage Northern High School for speaker support for third annual Portage CommuniTEEN READ event. Elizabeth Wein is the author of Code Name Verity. Discussion took place regarding clarity of the request, specifically what other support they have received in addition to ours. Gary to report back to board with the pros and cons. Gary also advised the board of the Hockey Classic promotion, where he plans to use Constant Contact to reach out earlier to the community for support.

Erica McCulley announced a request from Rotaract to support a service project to raise money to provide jackets for the needy. Rotaract is asking for \$85-100 for posters to assist. Discussion ensued with a suggestion to contact Allegra printing to see if they might cover this cost.

Mike Simon suggested that our Applications for Scholarships and Scholarship Certificates state that any scholarship granted carries with it a "moral obligation" to repay it to Charities. Such repayment would not be a legal obligation, would bind only the grantee's conscience. The grants would be interest free and without any due date. If the suggestion were adopted, there would be some chance that repayment when and if made would be "recycled" for additional scholarships.

Mike Simon commented on the issue of a "moral commitment vs legal commitment" regarding dues. The club will have already paid to Rotary International based on the roster at specific intervals and the implicit expectation is that a resigning member would reimburse the club for that portion of the dues expense before being granted termination or transfer. This will be addressed in the new policy draft to be presented at a future board meeting.

Jeannine Willacker requested leave of absence for period January 3 – February 3, 2018. MMSP that Jeannine Willacker be granted a Leave of Absence from January 3, 2018 through February 3, 2018

The next meeting of the Boards will be held at 7:30 AM, November 16, at Michelle's Restaurant in Portage, MI.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was, on Motion, adjourned at 8:45 a.m..
