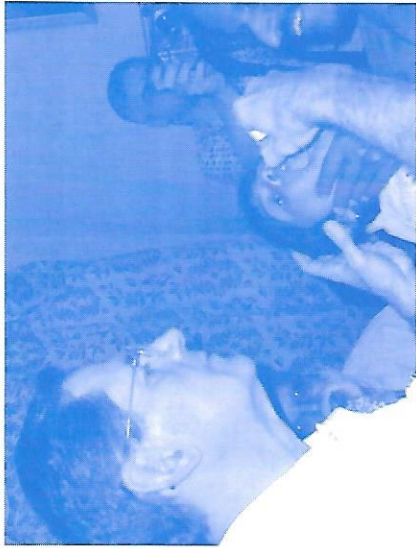
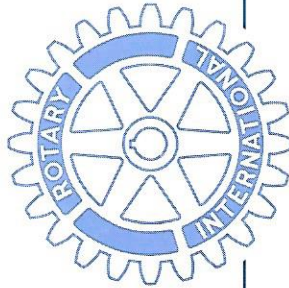


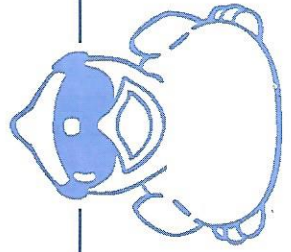

4. Will it be Beneficial to all concerned?



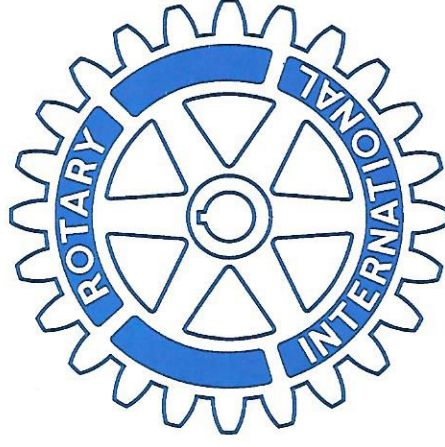
Did you know ...

- Rotary is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide, who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world.
- Rotary, the world's first service club, was founded in Chicago, Illinois on February 23, 1905.
- Rotary numbers 1.2 million service-minded men and women belonging to nearly 27,000 Rotary clubs in over 160 countries.
- Rotarians meet weekly for fellowship and for interesting and informative programs dealing with topics of local and global importance. Membership reflects a wide cross section of the community.
- Rotarians plan and carry out a remarkable variety of humanitarian, educational, and cultural exchange programs that touch people's lives in their local communities and our world community.
- The Rotary Foundation provides some \$60 million annually for international scholarships, cultural exchanges, and humanitarian projects large and small that improve the quality of life for millions of people.
- Rotary is PolioPlus, a 20-year commitment to work with national and international health organizations to eradicate polio by the year 2005, Rotary's 100th anniversary. Rotarians have provided human and financial resources to immunize more than one-half billion children in developing nations against polio.
